## NEGROAMARO

PUGLIA I.G.P.

*The Italian region of Puglia is home to the splendid Cattedrale di Ostuni consecrated to the Assumption of Mary and declared a national monument in 1902.*

It is one of Apulia's most famous vine varieties. The name, "Negro Amaro" or "Negroamaro", embodies its peculiar features such as the dark colour of the grapes and the slightly bitter aftertaste. To the nose it reveals an intense fragrance of prune and notes of olive. The finish is balsamic and spiced, with hints of pepper and liquorice that hark back to the Mediterranean marquis. It is a smooth and well-bodied red that is excellent with savoury pasta dishes, all kinds of meats and ripe cheeses.
